

TERMS AND CONDITIONS
\$150,000 Pearl Room Gaming Machine Jackpot

1. Promotion: \$150,000 Pearl Room Gaming Machine Jackpot

2. Promoter: Burswood Nominees Limited ABN 24 078 250 307 as trustee for The Burswood Property Trust ABN 35 491 489 282 trading as Crown Perth, Great Eastern Highway Burswood, Western Australia 6100.

3. Promotion Period and Entry Process: The \$150,000 Pearl Room Gaming Machine Jackpot will start from 6am Monday 30 November 2020 and will run until all Jackpot Winners are found. All patrons playing on eligible Gaming Machines in the Pearl Room (excludes any Quartz machines, Vegas Star, Lucky Sic Bo, Lucky Big Wheel and Fusion terminals) during the Promotional Period will be eligible to participate in the \$150,000 Pearl Room Gaming Machine Jackpot on the relevant Promotional Day.

Entrants must be 18 years of age or older. Entrants are ineligible if they are excluded from the property of the Promoter or they are ineligible under the Crown Resorts Limited Gambling by Employees Policy.

The \$150,000 Pearl Room Gaming Machine Jackpot will start from 6am and run until all fifteen (15) Jackpot Winner are found. Once all fifteen (15) Jackpot Winner are found, the \$150,000 Pearl Room Gaming Machine Jackpot will end.

The total number of Jackpot Winners for the \$150,000 Pearl Room Gaming Machine Jackpot is fifteen (15) for the Promotional Period. The Jackpot Winners will be randomly determined by the Gaming Machine Jackpot program during the Promotional time stated above.

All times recorded throughout these Terms and Conditions are in Australian Western Standard Time.

4. Jackpot Winner: The Prizes described below in Section 5 will be awarded to the Jackpot Winners.

5. Prize: The Prize for each of the fifteen (15) Jackpot Winners is \$10,000 cash.

6. Jackpot Value: The total value of all the Jackpots is \$150,000.

7. Jackpot Conditions: The Prize(s) are subject to the following conditions:

- a) **Taxes:** If a Prize(s) or receipt of it incurs a tax liability, the Jackpot Winner is liable for payment of such tax.
- b) The Jackpot Winner must provide personal identification to the satisfaction of the Promoter and must remain at the Gaming Machine until a Gaming Machine attendant arrives to be eligible to claim the Prize.
- c) If the Promoter is unable to successfully locate the Jackpot Winner after reasonable efforts to do so, or if the Jackpot Winner does not claim their Prize in accordance with the directions of the Promoter, the Jackpot Winner will have forfeited their right to the Jackpot and any Prize amount will be handled as per Section 15 of the Casino Control Act 1984 (WA).

8. Privacy: The Promoter may collect entrants' personal information, including name and contact details, for purposes associated with the conduct of the Promotion, including publicising the results. Uses may also include future promotion, marketing and publicity. The Promoter may disclose this information to an associated entity or other companies acting on the Promoter's behalf, which may include those located overseas in accordance with the Promoter's Privacy Policy. Unless otherwise advised by the entrant, each entrant consents to the retention and use of their information in this manner.

9. Winner Publicity: The Promoter reserves the right and licence to use Jackpot Winners' names, suburbs, photographs, images, likeness and the amount of the Jackpot Prize for the purpose of promoting and advertising Crown Rewards and Crown Perth unless a written request for anonymity is received from the Jackpot Winners.

10. Technical Malfunction: Any malfunction on any eligible Gaming Machine shall be dealt with in accordance with the authorised rules of the relevant eligible Gaming Machine. In the event of a malfunction, the Promoter, in its absolute discretion, may not award the Prize, may defer or cancel the Promotion, or select a different mechanic to determine the winner/s which will be announced within the

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Promoter's venue during the Promotional Period. The Promoter may also recover any prize incorrectly awarded to an entrant as a result of a technical malfunction.

- 11. Liability:** To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Promoter excludes liability for any problems or technical malfunction directly or indirectly associated with the Promotion. The Promoter's responsibility for the provision of prizes is limited to the Prizes as described in Conditions 5 and the Promoter accepts no further liability or commitment beyond that stated. The Promoter will not be responsible for any act, omission, failure or delay by the Promoter that is due to any acts which are not reasonably within its control, including as a result of any technical malfunction.
- 12. Indemnity:** To the fullest extent permissible by law, each participant including the Jackpot Winners, releases and indemnifies the Promoter from any claim, loss, damage, injury, expense, cost or charge sustained or in any way incurred in connection with the Prize or Promotion or participation in the Prize or Promotion. The Promoter, its related bodies corporate, their officers, employees and agents will not be liable for any loss, damage or personal injury whatsoever (including but not limited to direct, indirect, consequential and economic loss) suffered or sustained in connection with this Promotion, the promotion of this Promotion, or the use of any Prize, except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law.
- 13. Force Majeure:** The Promoter will not be responsible for any forces of nature, acts of God, war (declared or undeclared), riot, explosion, acts of terrorism, labour or industrial dispute including strike, action or inaction of Government, forced or Government imposed closure of the venue or cessation of or interruption to trade and any other acts which are not reasonably within the control of the Promoter which may affect the Promotion. If one or more of these acts occur, the Promoter reserves the right to cancel the Promotion, defer the Promotion to a different date, or change these Terms and Conditions. Any change to the Promotion in these circumstances will be communicated to eligible entrants as soon as practicable.
- 14. Disputes:** In the event of a dispute, the decision of the Promoter is final and binding.
- 15. Alteration:** The Promoter reserves the right to alter these Terms and Conditions to address any misinterpretation, misinformation or misunderstanding that may arise in the application of these Terms and Conditions. The Promoter's decision will be final.
- 16. Acceptance:** Participation in the Promotion constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
- 17. Cancellation:** The Promoter reserves the right to cancel the Promotion at any time prior to the commencement of the Promotion Period for any reason.
